INSTRUCTIONS

URINE SAMPLE COLLECTION



Please read the instructions carefully before collecting your sample.

Check that your kit includes:

- Biohazard bag
- Instruction sheet
- Sample transport tube Registration card
- Urine collection box Barcode label
- Prepaid shipping label Return mailer
- · Lab requisition form

Warnings, Precautions and Cautions:

- DO NOT use the kit if it has expired.
- DO NOT apply the liquid in the transport tube directly to skin, nose or mouth.
- DO NOT drink the liquid in the bottle or take internally.
- DO NOT wash your genital area.
- DO NOT perform collection within 7 days of taking antibiotics.
- DO NOT drink alcohol on the day of collection
- DO NOT collect sample during menstruation or within 24 hours ofintercourse
- DO NOT empty liquid preservative from tube
- DO use first morning urine, if possible.

First Aid Measures:	
IF IN EYES:	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, contact a healthcare practitioner for medical advice or attention.
IF ON SKIN:	Wash with plenty of soap and water. If skin irritation occurs, contact a healthcare practitioner for medical advice or attention.
IF SWALLOWED:	Rinse mouth. DO NOT induce vomiting. Contact a POISON CENTER or a doctor if you feel unwell.
IF INHALED:	If breathing is difficult, move to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If experiencing respiratory symptoms, contact a POISON CENTER or a doctor.

Reagent Composition and Information on Ingredients:

Chemical name:	Concentration:
HEPES (7365-45-9)	1 - 5%
Ammonium Sulfate (7783-20-2)	1 - 5%

Store unused kit in a dry place at room temperature (15°C to 30°C or 59°F to 86°F) prior to use.

Directions:

- 1. Register your kit at www.mylabbox.com/register
- 2. Fill out the laboratory requisition form.
- **3.** Wash your hands.
- 4. Locate the urine collection box. Squeeze the box to pop it open.
- **5.** Urinate directly into the collection box.
- 6. Collect approximately 20mL to 30mL (6 teaspoons). **DO NOT** fill the entire cup.
- 7. Locate the sample transport tube. Write your name, date of birth and date of collection in the MM/DD/YYYY format on the tube's label.
- **8.** Remove the cap from the transport tube. **DO NOT** pour out liquid already in the tube.
- **9.** Use one of the corners of the urine collection box as a spout and slowly pour the urine into the tube. Fill until volume is between the two fill lines.
- **10.** Re-cap the tube and make sure it is sealed well.
- 11. Place the tube in the biohazard bag. DO NOT remove the absorbent pad in the bag. Seal the bag.
- 12. Place the bag and completed lab requisition form into the box and ship using the postage-paid envelope provided. You can leave the envelope in your mailbox or at any USPS pickup location.
